Dear Commissioners:

I am writing to fully express my support for the applications by Sinclair Oil & Gas Company and Four Sevens Operating Company ("Sinclair") to develop the mineral resources beneath the City of Big Spring by horizontally drilling on pooled units.

According to industry sources, it is estimated that the total recoverable hydrocarbon reserves in the Spraberry Formation beneath an area the size of Big Spring could exceed 100 million barrels of oil, using existing and future recovery technologies. At current prices, this oil would have a value of about 6 billion dollars. This development would yield substantial new revenue for decades to come for Big Spring.

Our city's history includes the discovery of oil in the region during the 1920s, marking the beginning of the prolific oil industry in the Permian Basin. However, the oil and gas business hit its peak in Big Spring during the 1950s.
